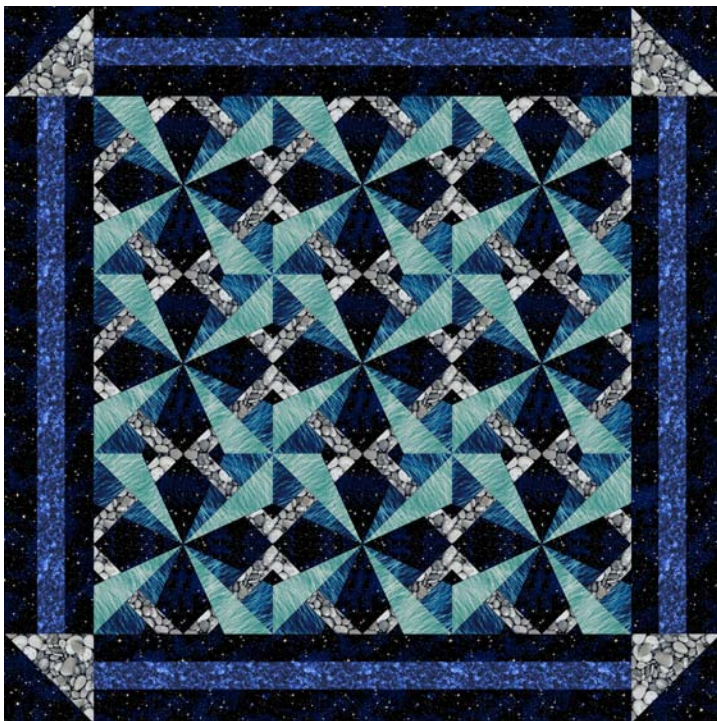

How the  
blocks can  
be used



Pam is using Starbound and Le Moyne together to create a Salad Bar. She's planning a runner for the center of her dining table with one Starbound center block and two Le Moyne's on either side.



Yolanda is planning a quilt using the blue colorway of her Landscape Quilter fabrics. Note that there are four Starbound blocks in the center surrounded by half-blocks. The warm color version will be a fall table trivet.





## November Tip for Paper-Piecers

### Joining Blocks

For greater accuracy when joining blocks or sections of blocks with matching points:

1. Do not remove the paper.
2. Trim your finished block on the outside dashed line which will give you a 1/4" seam allowance. Go ahead and use your rotary cutter to trim the paper. Carol Doak states in her video that she's been using her rotary cutter to cut paper and fabric forever and it DOES NOT dull the blade. She states 'paper is a fiber product too'. We trust her.
3. Line up the blocks with the aid of the crisp paper edges. Machine baste the blocks at the match points and the corners before sewing. Check for accuracy. If all points are matching, then go ahead and join the blocks in the regular way. If points don't match, remove the basting stitches and try again. You can leave basting stitches in or take it out after sewing.
