
SQUANGLE | APRIL BLOCK OF THE MONTH

The theme of this block is teals, pinks and oranges! The unfinished block is $12-\frac{1}{2} \times 12-\frac{1}{2}$; finished block is 12×12 . I've never designed a block before this one! Trying new things : D



Fabric Cuts:

A: 1-1/2 x 10-1/2

B1: 1-½ x 9-½ B2: 2-½ x2-½

C1: $3-\frac{1}{2} \times 3-\frac{1}{2}$ C2: $2-\frac{1}{2} \times 2-\frac{1}{2}$

D1: 1-1/2 x 6-1/2 D2: 2-1/2 x 8-1/2

E1: 2-1/2 x 6-1/2 E2: 2-1/2 x 4-1/2

F: $2^{-1/2} \times 8^{-1/2}$

G1: 1-½ x 6-½ G2: 2-½ x 2-½

H: 6-½ x 6-½

I: $2-\frac{1}{2} \times 2-\frac{1}{2}$

Brights? Muted? I can't wait to see what you've chosen...

So my math worked out (yay!) and I had to make an adjustment to my original drawing to make it piece together properly, but I figured it out:

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Using ¼" seams and pressing open:

- 1. Piece E2 to B2 on their 2-1/2" sides
- 2. Piece G1 to H [left side] and E2/B2 to H [right side]
- 3. Piece D1 to **TOP** of E1 along their $6-\frac{1}{2}$ " sides
- 4. Piece C1 to D1/E1 [left side]
- 5. Piece B1 to TOP of C1/D1/E1



- 6. Piece B1/C1/D1/E1 onto G1/H/E2/B2
- 7. Piece F to I
- 8. Piece C2 to G2
- 9. Piece C2/G2 to D2

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10. Piece A to left side ofB1-E1+G1-B2 then,11. Piece F/I to right side12. Piece D2/C2/G2 to bottomand.....
